

Mr. William D. Jones is the President, Chief Executive Officer, and Director at CityLink Investment Corporation. He has held the current position since October 1993. Prior to that time, Mr. Jones served for The Prudential Realty Group as General Manager/Senior Asset Manager of a commercial real estate portfolio in the Northwestern United States since January 1992 and as an Investment Manager since July 1990, where he joined in July 1989 as an Investment Manager and Assistant to the Chairman. He served as a Director of The Price Real Estate Investment Trust Inc., since 1991. He served as a Director of Price REIT, Inc. since 1991.
