W. Timothy Hushen is Chief, Sponsored Research Services of the San Diego State University Foundation, which is the largest research foundation in the California State University system with revenues of over \$175 million/year. He manages and directs more than 50 professionals in developing over 1,000 proposals for external funding and supervises the administration of \$140 million grant, contract, and self-support activities. He has more than 25 years experience in developing, securing funding, and managing major national and international science, technology, business development, and educational programs.

Before joining San Diego State University Foundation in 1989, Tim was actively involved in developing and managing major programs in the Arctic and Antarctic with the National Academy of Sciences and as the founding Executive Director of the Presidential U.S. Arctic Research Commission. His private sector experience includes establishing and managing a development and manufacturing facility which produces medical diagnostic testing products.

He is a founding member and serves on the Board of the Consortium for Commercialization of Advanced Technology, as well as serving on the Board of the San Diego Regional Technology Alliance and as an officer of the East County Economic Development Council. He represents San Diego State University on the Arctic Research Consortium of the United States and served on the Salton Sea Science Committee.

Mr. Hushen has published several articles on science and technology and has provided expert testimony to the United States Congress. He was selected as a member of the *International Who's Who* and as one of the twenty-five major contributors to SDSU. He graduated from Alma College with a Bachelor of Sciences in Biology and from the University of Michigan with a Master of Science in Plant Ecology.
